Day 1: FRANKFURT

Day 2: FRANKFURT TO RHINELAND

Day 3: FRANKFURT TO MUNICH

Breakfast and check-out of the hotel. Transfer to the Frankfurt Main station for your train to Munich, **Munich** is the capital city of Bavaria (Bayern), Germany. It is located on the River Isar north of the Bavarian Alps. Munich is the third largest city in Germany, after Berlin and Hamburg. There are about 1.35 million people living within city limits. Munich hosted the 1972 Summer Olympics and is a candidate city for the 2018 Winter Olympics. Overnight in Munich.

Day 04: The Royal Castles Neuschwanstein and Linderhof

After the breakfast we will visit two of Ludwig II's dream castles at Neuschwanstein and Linderhof, in the heart of the Bavarian Alps. Hidden in the seclusion of the mountains, Ludwig II built two of his dream castles: Neuschwanstein and Linderhof. This excursion shows you these two extraordinary castles, both testifying to the vision of Bavaria's fairytale King. Guided tours are included in both castles. For English and German language the guided tours will be done by a live guide, all other languages will be provided by a headphone. There is also time for a short stop for souvenir shopping in Oberammergau. **Neuschwanstein Castle** is a 19th-century Gothic Revival palace on a rugged hill above the village of Hohenschwangau near Füssen in southwest Bavaria, Germany. The palace was commissioned by Ludwig II of Bavaria as a retreat and as homage to Richard Wagner.



The palace was intended as a personal refuge for the reclusive king, but it was opened to the paying public immediately after his death in 1886. Since then over 60 million people have visited Neuschwanstein Castle. More than 1.3 million people visit annually, with up to 6,000 per day in the summer.^[3] The palace has appeared prominently in several movies and was the inspiration for Disneyland's Sleeping Beauty Castle.
