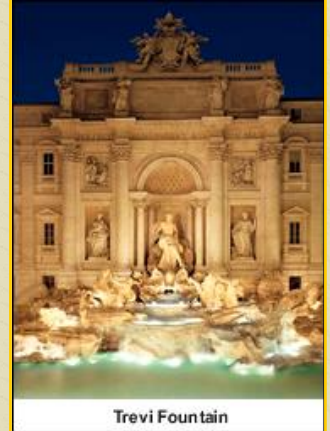


5 nights Italian Treasure

Day 01: Arrival in Rome and Transfer to the hotel which is few meters away from the Rome termini station. Day free to explore the eternal city on your own. Rome is one of the most popular tourist destinations in the European Union. Visitors come from around the world to see world-famous landmarks such as the Colosseum, the Forum and the Pantheon. Rome has tourist attractions for all tastes, Young couples love to throw three coins into Trevi Fountain, climb the Spanish Steps or enjoy a latte in Piazza Navona. Overnight in Rome.

Day 02: After Breakfast, proceed for a full day city tour of Rome with Lunch. This tour begins by passing through the Via Veneto, made famous by Fellini's Dolce Vita film. Before reaching Via Nazionale we cross Piazza della Repubblica with Najadi's Fountain. Our walk through the historical centre starts with the Trevi Fountain and continues to Piazza Navona, built on the ancient Domitian Stadium with the famous Fountain of the Four Rivers, Bernini's masterpiece. Along the way we admire Piazza Colonna so called due to



the Column of Marco Aurelio. Visit the interior of the Pantheon which was built in the First Century B.C. with the biggest dome in the world as requested by Emperor Hadrian. Continue by coach to St. Peter's Square passing Castel St. Angelo. We visit the Basilica of St. Peter's to admire, among other treasures, the Pieta' by Michelangelo. After lunch Crossing Piazza della Repubblica with Najadi's Fountain, we continue along Via Nazionale to Piazza Venezia at the heart of the city with its Monument to Victor Emanuel II, also called 'Vittoriano'. We walk up to Capitol



Square, designed by Michelangelo, and take in the magnificent view over the Roman Forum and Palatine. By coach, passing the Teatro Marcello, Aventine Hill and the Circus Maximus, we arrive at and enter the ancient basilica of St. Peter in Chains, where you can admire the statue of Moses by Michelangelo. Afterwards we stop in front of the Colosseum from which point you can see the Arches of Constantine and Tito and the Temple of Venus and Rome. Passing the Pyramid of Cestia, we arrive at St. Paul's Outside the Walls to see the site where the Apostle of the People was buried. Overnight in Rome.

Day 03: Breakfast and Check out of the hotel and take a train from Rome to Florence. Check in at Hotel. Day is your own freshen up and explore the city of Florence.



Florence is the capital city of the Italian region of Tuscany and of the province of Florence. It is the most populous city in Tuscany, with 367,569 inhabitants (1,500,000 in the metropolitan area).

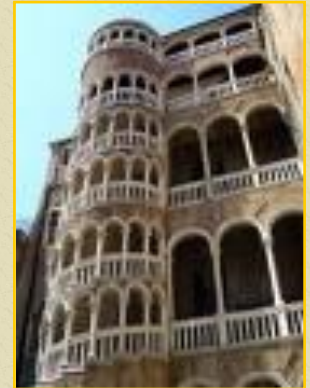
The city lies on the River Arno and is known for its history and its importance in the Middle Ages and in the Renaissance especially for its art and architecture. A centre of medieval European trade and finance and one of the wealthiest cities of the time, Florence is considered the birthplace of the Renaissance; it has been called the Athens of the Middle Ages. A turbulent political history included periods of rule by the powerful Medici family, religious and republican revolution. From 1865 to 1870 the city was also the capital of the Kingdom of Italy. Florence is often known as the "Jewel of the Renaissance". Overnight in Florence.



Day 04: After the Breakfast An opportunity to take in some wonderful scenery en route to the historic university town of Pisa, most famous for its curious Leaning Tower. A splendid excursion through the fertile and picturesque Tuscan countryside towards the historic university city of Pisa, famous for its architectural beauty.



After a panoramic drive along the beautiful riversides, the tour proceeds with a guided tour to Piazza dei Miracoli to find the celebrated Leaning Tower, the Cathedral, an unequalled masterpiece of Romanesque art carried out between the 11th and 12th centuries, the Baptistery and other important monuments. You will then walk to Piazza dei Cavalieri, where the Scuola Normale, one of the most famous universities in the world, resides. Overnight in Florence.



Day 05: Breakfast at the Hotel. Checkout and its time to catch the train to one of the most romantic cities in Europe **VENICE**. Arrival at Venice and check in to your hotel. The "City of Bridges", as it is usually called, stretches along the mouths of the Po and the Piave rivers. Out of the 270,000 inhabitants, about 62,000 live in the historic center, or city



of Venice, about 176,000 live in the mainland or "Terraferma", behind the lagoon, in locations like Mestre and Marghera, and all the others live on islands throughout the lagoon (islands around Venice are about one-hundred). Also known as a magnetic point for sweethearts, lovers, artists and poets, Venice is a magic city, which stretches across numerous small islands.



It is often referred to as the city of "gondole", which are the means of transportation used to cross the City
