ITINERARY

DAY 1: BARCELONA

On arrival in Barcelona and transfer to the Hotel. After checking-in at the hotel, enjoy the rest of the day at leisure or explore the exuberant city on your own. Overnight at the Hotel.

DAY 2: BARCELONA Morning City Visit

After the Breakfast be ready for the half day city tour, this tour departs from the bus terminal and continues to the port via Leyatena where we will see the Cathedral, the Gothic Quarter and Plaza St.Jaume. We continue to the Olympic Village, then it's on to Montjuich for a panoramic view of the city and port. The tour will take you past the Columbus Statue and on to the Olympic Stadium and St Jordi Palace. Then it's time for a visit to the Spanish Village and while there you'll have the opportunity to taste the famous Catalonian Cava. The tour returns past the famous Plaza De Espana to the bus terminal, where the tour finishes. Overnight at the Hotel.

DAY 3: BARCELONA to Malaga

After the breakfast Transfers to The city of Malaga Spain with its approximately 550 000 habitants the second largest city of Andalusia, lies about 370 km to the south of Alicante along the Costa del Sol. Overnight at the Hotel.

DAY 4: Malaga by your Own

After Breakfast, take an optional tour of Malaga while travelling on a double-decker bus. This tour is operated by double-decker open-top buses offering the most convenient way to discover the most interesting museums and attractive sights this exciting city has to offer. You can get on and off as many times as you wish at any of the 12 stops, within the same ticket. Overnight at the Hotel

DAY 5: Malaga to MADRID

After the breakfast the capital of Spain since 1562, is located at the geographic center of the Iberian Peninsula. Because of its central location and high altitude, the climate of Madrid is characterized by warm dry summers and cool winters.

Madrid is a city of great monuments. Among its highlights are the medieval centers dating back to the Habsburg Empire and the Prado Museum but Madrid is not just a cultural destination. It is also a lively metropolis with many pubs, cafes, discotheques and nightclubs open late into the night. Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 6: MADRID "From Madrid to Heaven"

After the breakfast enjoy a half day sightseeing tour to the historical city of Cordoba to visit the Mezquita, Alcazar and Synagogue. Day is your own after the city tour, overnight at the hotel.

Day 7: Transfers to Barcelona Airport

After the Breakfast pack your bag and transfers to Barcelona for onward journey to your Home.
